**January 19, 2010**

Meeting was called to order.

The November minutes were read and approved.

Principal's Report: Midyear conference forms will be going home. These are not mandatory, but teachers or parents can request a conference on Feb 5<sup>th</sup> or anytime within the next 2 weeks.
